

Miami Wins 2nd Loop Track Title

ATHENS —(AP)— Scoring in all 14 events, Miami's racing Redskins won the second annual mid-American conference track-field championship yesterday with a total of 75½ points, 30 ahead of second-place western Michigan.

Cincinnati's Bearcats were fifth with 16 points, and Butler drew up in last place with 13. Miami replaces Wayne as conference champion. Wayne withdrew from the tight little loop.
