

(Special)—Miami University's mighty track<sup>N</sup> and field team walked off with its sixth consecutive Mid-American Conference championship today in the annual MAC spring sports carnival at Western Michigan College.

Miami also won its first tennis championship, while Ohio University won the golf crown for the third year in a row.

Redskin cindermen, sweeping to 10 first places, broke four conference records in their one-sided triumph. They piled up 89½ points, with Western Michigan's 46½ good enough for second. Trailing were Bowling Green 24½, Cincinnati 20½, Western Reserve 18½, Marshall 9½ and Kent State 1½.
