OXFORD (AP)—Miami University, capturing seven first places, Saturday won its seventh consecutive Mid-American Conference track championship.

The Redskins compiled 99 $\frac{2}{5}$ points to edge out the strong contingent from Western Michigan, with 89 $\frac{9}{10}$. Western Reserve, scheduled to leave the conference at the end of next Spring's competition, was third with 30. Bowling Green followed with 17 $\frac{1}{5}$, Ohio University earned 11 and Kent State was last with 7 $\frac{1}{2}$.
