BALTIMORE - Olympians Julius Sang and Robert Ouko of Kenya sparked North Carolina Central to its second straight Mid-Eastern Athletic Association track and field championship here Sunday.

Sang ran on the Eagles' winning 440 and mile relay teams, won the 440 in a meet record 46.6 and placed second in the long jump. Ouko won the 880 in a meet record 1:51.6, finished second in the mile and ran on NCCU's mile relay team.

Central also won three other events. Charles Foster took the high hurdles in a record 13.7,
