

Hornet women second, men fourth in MEAC track

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. — St. Dorcus Turner set records in three individual events and was voted the Most Outstanding Female Athlete after leading Delaware State College to a second-place finish at the 11th Annual Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Track and Field Championships at Florida A&M University Saturday.

In the men's division, Delaware State had a disappointing fourth-place finish, with 84 points. Andre Johnson was the only Hornet to win an event, the 5,000-meter run with a time of 16:06.7.

Turner shattered the MEAC record in the 3,000-meter run, one she set last year at the outdoor championships with a time of 11:45.07. Going out and setting the pace with teammate Donna Ray, Turner turned in a 10:59.38 to win the event and Ray was second in 11:01.78.

"I was pleased with my performance today. I came through like the coach wanted me too," said Turner, a sophomore. "Our team was disappointed that we got second place, but there is always next year. We made a few mistakes but we plan to get it together — we just have to practice

a little harder."

Turner also set marks in the 1500-meter run with a time of 4:42.1 and the 800-meter dash in 2:12.65, pacing the Hornets to second place with 124½ team points. South Carolina won the championship with 158½ points, Howard was third with 87. FAMU placed fourth with 79, followed by North Carolina A&T with 12, Maryland Eastern-Shore with seven and Bethune-Cookman in last with no points.

Javaro Sims won the 100-meter dash in 10.85 and placed first in the 200-meter dash in 21.30 to win the Most Outstanding Male Athlete award and lead host FAMU to the championship with 150 points.

South Carolina State won eight of 15 events to capture the women's title, ruining DelState's plans to win its second-straight MEAC outdoor championship, after the Hornets took the indoor championship earlier in the year. But the Hornets were impressive.

DelState's Marshelliese Best came up with her finest throw ever in the discus event and won with a toss of 132-8½. Best also was fifth in the shot put with a throw of 33-6¾. Sherice Smaw placed sec-

ond in the shot put with a 40-8¾ and came back to take second in the javalin throw with a toss of 117-3. Freshman Doneice Harvin was fifth in the javalin throw with a 87-6. Besides placing second in the 3,000-meter run, Ray was just a step or two behind Turner.

For the DelState men, Lenny Jordan was fourth in the 100-meter dash in 11.07 and placed fourth in the 200.
