

Host South Carolina State won all four titles up for grabs Saturday at the 15th annual Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference spring championships.

The State men's track team behind eight first place finishes, amassed a team total of 155 points to outdistance second place Delaware State, which had 122 for the conference Outdoor Track and Field title. It was the fifth straight title for the men. North Carolina A&T finished fourth with 76 points followed by Howard 74, Maryland-Eastern Shore 20, Morgan State 12, and Bethune-Cookland with 1.

State's Darry Simmons, who won the 100 meters (10.6) and the 200 meters (21.3), was named the most outstanding performer in the men's division.

In the women's division, State, behind three first place finishes by Colette Williams and one by Della Wilson, compiled 169 points to 122 for Delaware State to claim their sixth consecutive championship. Howard and Morgan State finished third and fourth with 78 and 56 points, respectively. Rounding out the field was Maryland-Eastern Shore with 35 followed by North Carolina A&T with and Bethune-Cookland with 1.

Williams, who captured the long jump (19-2), high jump (5-4) and the triple jump (40-5½) was selected the outstanding women performer.

The men's tennis team won five of six singles matches to roll up 26 points to earn their third straight MEAC title. Howard was second with 19 points followed by North Carolina A&T and Delaware State with nine points each.

The women also captured five singles titles enroute to amassing 76 points to capture the MEAC's first women's tennis championship. Howard took second place with 16 points to out distance Morgan State with nine and North Carolina A&T with six.

The Bulldogs' James Standfield and Michelle Johnson was selected most outstanding in the tennis division.
