B-CC, UMES claim titles

Bethune-Cookman won the women's division and Maryland-Eastern Shore the men's crown during the 17th annual MEAC Indoor Track and Field Championships, which concluded Sunday at the Greensboro Coliseum.

Bethune-Cookman's title was its first, while UMES captured its second straight championship.

In the women's event, Nicole Carty of Bethune-Cookman placed first in three events, anchored the record-breaking distance medley relay team and was on the third-place 1,600-meter relay squad, earning 34 individual points and the MEAC Outstanding Female Performer Award. Carty won the 800-meter run (2:18.67), the 1,500 meters (4:55.96), and the 3,000 meters (10:49.24). The distance medley team, consisting of Karen

Williams, Chrystal Finlayson, Nicole Bryan and Carty, turned in a time of 12:52.01 to break the old mark held by Coppin State since 1994. Bethune-Cookman's Curtis L. Pittman was tabbed the MEAC Outstanding Coach for the women's division.

Johnny Splunge of UMES was named the MEAC men's Most Outstanding Performer for the second consecutive year, while the Outstanding Coach award went to UMES mentor Charles McLaughlin. Splunge accumulated 27.5 points by finishing first in the 400-meter dash (49.10), second in the 55 meters (6.45) and second in the 200 (22.24) and helping his team to second in the 1.600-meter relay.
