

Carleton Has Easy Time in State Meet

Northfield, Minn., June 4.—Carleton had an easy time winning the annual Minnesota intercollegiate track and field meet on Laird field this afternoon. The Maize and Blue team amassed a total of 86½ points, which was more than the combined scores of all the other teams entered in the meet. St. Olaf was second with 25 points, Hamline third with 18½, St. Thomas fourth with 16½, Macalester fifth with 14½ and St. John's least with 3½.

Because last year's meet was the first held, any mark which bettered that made last year constituted a new record. On the whole it was faster than the first, eight records being broken and one tied.

Worlein of Carleton and Canton of St. Olaf led the record smashing with two each. Worlein set up new marks in both of the dashes with 10 2-5 seconds in the century and 22 2-5 seconds in the 220 yards dash. In both of these races he led by a good margin and would undoubtedly have made better time had he been harder pressed. Canton made remarkable time in both of the distance runs, with the low mark of 10 minutes 9 3-5 seconds in the two-mile and four minutes 39 1-5 seconds in the mile. Allen of Carleton beat his own record in the high hurdles with a mark of 15 2-5 seconds.

Lescault of St. Thomas was high point man of the meet with 13 points.
