

Northfield, Minn., June 2.—Taking 11 firsts and placing men in the other four of 15 events staged, Carleton college athletes won the Minnesota intercollegiate track and field tournament on Laird field here today for the fourth consecutive year. The Carletonians scored 101 points, more than the number collected by the other four teams combined. Hamline was second with 30½; St. Olaf third with 16½; Macalester fourth with 9, and St. Thomas fifth with 2 points.

The meet was exceptionally fast, seven records being broken and one other tied.

Individual Honors Tied.

Three athletes tied for high individual scoring honors, Johnston and Naused of Carleton, and Brandes of Hamline, each collecting two firsts for 10 points. Naused, in addition, ran on the winning relay team.

The most outstanding performance of the tourney was the record heave in the javelin by chubby John Sprandel of Carleton. After breaking the record in competition with 170 feet, he hurled the spear again in record trials and bettered his mark by eight feet, four inches. The old mark was held by John Kobs of Hamline set in 1921, 169 feet, nine inches.

One of the prettiest running races was the 440-yard event in which Naused of Carleton, and Simons of Hamline, ran neck and neck for nearly 200 yards. Naused then forged ahead, Simons falling back to fourth place when H. and R. March, also of Carleton, cut in ahead of him at the finish. Naused cut his former record from 51 3-5 seconds to 50 1-10.

Other New Records.

Other new records established were: One-mile run, Brandes, Hamline, 4:32 3-10; 220-yard low hurdles, R. March, :26 flat; one-mile relay, Carleton, 3:28 1-10; discus, Middlemist, Carleton, 129 feet; broad jump, Wilcox, Macalester, 22 feet, 2½ inches; "Whitey" Fevold of St. Olaf, tied the high jump record at 5 feet, 9¼ inches.
