

Northfield, Minn., May 29.—St. Olaf college of Northfield coasted to a second straight Minnesota College Conference track and field championship here Saturday by amassing a total of 58½ points to defeat the runnerup Macalester team of St. Paul which collected 44 points.

Hamline finished third with 14½ points, followed by St. Thomas and Gustavus Adolphus with 14, St. John's, 13, and Concordia, 7.
