

Talent packed St. Thomas made a shambles of the 33rd annual Minnesota College conference track meet Wednesday night at O'Shaughnessy stadium to take its fourth straight championship.

Placing in all but one of the 14 events, the Tommies piled up 71 points to far outdistance runner-up Macalester at 40½. Gustavus and St. Olaf tied for third with 25 apiece, St. John's notched 23, Hamline 19, Duluth Branch 6 and Augsburg one-half point.

THREE RECORDS were written into the books, none by the Tommies, who previous to last night owned half of the MIAC marks.

Macalester's John Hauzenblas, as expected, raised the high jump level. The soaring Czech's leap of 6 feet, 2¾ inches nudged him over the old mark of 6-1⅞ set by Earl Erickson of St. Thomas in 1949.

The Macs' mile relay team of Paul Hedstrom, Dwight Atherton, John King and Don Wallin lived up to expectations also, turning in a 3:27.5, two-tenths of a second under the previous mark set back in 1937 by another Macalester quartet.

THE UNEXPECTED was Bill Schirber's sparkling 1:58.1 in the half-mile—a good six-tenths under St. Thomas' Glenn Porterfield's 1950 standard. The St. John's middle distance star, expected to have trouble with Walt Kurth of St. Thomas and Macalester's King, won with surprising ease.

Otherwise, the biggest surprise was Pat Moriarity's double victory over his St. Thomas teammate Bert Budd.
