

C. U. Sets Scoring Record of 71 Points to Win Mason-Dixon Conference Track Meet

BALTIMORE, Md., May 18. Amassing a scoring record of 71 points, Catholic University, of Washington, today captured the Mason-Dixon Conference's Track and Field championships for the second year in succession at Homewood Field here.

It was a brilliant victory for the Cardinals, who won five first places, one a tie, in the fifth annual meet. The runner-up for team honors, Johns Hopkins University, was far back with 48½ points, and Delaware was third with three markers.

John Corbett, C. U.'s running star, earned the lion's share of laurels in the track events, winning both the one-mile and two-mile runs in handy fashion. He set a new meet record in the two-mile events with a time of 9:56 9-10.

Five meet records, in all, fell by the boards, and one other Washingtonian, Stevens, of Gallaudet, figured in it. Stevens finished in a tie with Douglas, of Delaware, for first place in the running high jump event, both leaping six feet for a new mark.

Cleveland Stauffer gave Catholic University its lone victory in the field competition when he shared first place with Jackson, of Washington College, in the running broad jump, both jumping 20 feet, 5½ inches.

The Cardinals took first and second in the one mile run when Corbett led his teammate, John Doyle, across the finish line. The

same Doyle beat out Charles O'Keefe, also of the Cardinals, in another race in which the Washingtonians ended up one-two.

John Weschler gave the victorious District team another triumph when he outsprinted a clever field in the 220-yard race in :22 7-10. In his record-setting effort in the two-mile test, Corbett remained bunched with the other competitors in the early stages, gradually drew away from the field and romped home by a wide margin.

Trailing Catholic University, John Hopkins and Delaware for team honors were the following colleges: Washington, 28; Blue Ridge, 12½; Gallaudet, 8½; Western Maryland, 8; American University of Washington, 2½; Towson Teachers, 0; Loyola College, 0.

Other new meet records were established by Pardew, Hopkins, in the pole-vault competition, and by Rosenthal, Hopkins, in the discus throw and 16-pound shot-put test.
