

An inspired Gallaudet track team swept the Mason-Dixon Conference championship at Catholic University yesterday, swamping the defending titleholders, Johns Hopkins, and scoring a clean margin over a Catholic University squad that twice had trounced Gallaudet in dual meets.

Gallaudet chalked up 95½ points to 79½ for Catholic University, 28 for Bridgewater and 21 for Johns Hopkins. Loyola, which Friday broke off athletic relations with Catholic U. after a dispute over a forfeited baseball game, entered a squad in the meet but failed to score a point.

The hard-earned victory of Gallaudet gave the college's track coach, English Sullivan, cause for double celebration. Yesterday was Sullivan's birthday and he's about to enter military service. His speedsters joyfully presented him with the Mason-Dixon championship.

A meet record was set when Richards of Bridgewater cleared 12 feet in the pole vault. The old conference mark was 11 feet 6 inches. Richards not only hung up a record, but scored 18 of Bridgewater's points.

Vincent Campanella of Catholic U. was a double winner, in the 100 and 220 yard dashes. Stanley of Gallaudet also took two firsts, in the 440 and 880.
