

Newark, Del., May 10 [Special]—Catholic University took six first places to win the twelfth annual Mason-Dixon Conference Track and Field meet this afternoon at Frazer Field with 59 points.

Johns Hopkins was second with 54½ points. Third place went to Delaware with 50½ points, followed by American U., 19; Washington College, 14½; Western Maryland, 8; Hampden Sydney, 7; Gallaudet, 4½, and Loyola and Bridgewater tied for last with 4 points each.

Schwartz Gets Record

Leon Schwartz, of Johns Hopkins, set a new Mason-Dixon Conference record in the 440-yard run, going the distance in 50.6.

Setting the pace for Catholic University, Chester Hackett took first in the 1-mile run. Jim Duppa was first in the 330-yard run, Salvatore Consolo heaved the discus 124 feet and 6½ inches to win first place.

Bill Moody Wins

Bill Moody was first in the broad jump and Len Doegeo won the 220-yard low hurdles in 27 seconds flat. Bob Blosk won the 120-yard high hurdles.

Bob Portness, of Johns Hopkins took an early lead in the 2-mile event and was an easy winner with George Brown, of Loyola, in second place.
