BALTIMORE, May 10.—Bridge-water College's big track team walked off with the 17th running of the Mason-Dixon Conference track and field championship meet today to give the Virginia school its first victory in that event.

The Virginians failed to share in the record breaking, as two meet marks fell. But they wrapped up a total of 58 7/10 points out of 209 divided among 11 colleges. Washington College of Chestertown, Md., was second with 32 1/5 points.

In third place were Johns Hopkins, the host school, and Catholic University, each with 28 1/2 points. Loyola of Baltimore finished fifth with 15 7/10 points.

Kenny Howard of Washington was a standout performer, accounting for 18 points as he set a meet broad jump record, won the 220-yard dash and finished second in the 100-yard dash and the 220-yard low hurdles.
