

# Roanoke Wins Mason-Dixon Track Meet As 7 Marks Fall

Roanoke College captured six championships yesterday and ran away from the field to take top honors in the twenty-first annual Mason-Dixon Conference track and field championships at Home-wood, which were highlighted by seven record-breaking performances.

The Virginia thinclads garnered a total of 63 points in the two-day affair and broke two records in the process. Both Roanoke records were set by Hurdler Dave Foltz, who negotiated the 220-yard low hurdles in 24.2 to eclipse the old mark by eight tenths of a second and leaped over the 120-yard high hurdles in 15.1.

## Catholic U. Second

Catholic University took the runner-up spot to Roanoke with a total of 37 points, far behind the winner's score. The Washington squad took four firsts, including two record-shattering performances.

Catholic U.'s mile relay team of Mike Flynn, Bob Dockerty, George Mathews and Bob Flynn beat back a last-ditch rally by the Roanoke foursome to take the event in a meet record time of 3 minutes 22.3 seconds, while Roanoke also topped the former mark of 3.25.4, with a clocking of 3.22.6.

## Leibert Sets Mark

Catholic's other mark came in the 220-yard dash as John Liebert sped the straightaway distance in 21.3 to cut five tenths of a second off the old mark.

Other marks to fall during the meet were the broad jump, the pole vault and the shot put.

Charles Nuttycombe, Randolph-Macon's all around man leaped to a new mark of 23-feet 1½-inches to eclipse the old broad jump mark of 22 9½-inches.

## New Shot Record

Jim Frazer, Hampden-Sydney's ace weightman topped his own meet mark of 47-feet 6-inches with a heave of 48-feet 10¼-inches.

Lynchburg's pole-vaulter Taylor Goode climaxed the meet as he soared to 13-feet 1½-inches, breaking the old mark by 1½ inches. Goode attempted a 13-foot 5½-inch height, but failed on all three tries.

Following Roanoke and Catholic U., were Hopkins, the host team, with 22 points, just edging out Hampden-Sydney which tallied 20½. Lynchburg came next
