

**HAMPDEN-SYDNEY, May 18**  
—Roanoke College piled up 76½ points to win its fourth straight Mason-Dixon Conference track championship here today in a meet that produced three new conference records.

Coach Homer Bast's Maroons, led by double-winner Bruce Johnston, who set a record in the low hurdles and tie a record in the high hurdles, never were threatened. They won six of the 14 events on the program.

Catholic University finished second with 26 points followed in order by host Hampden-Sydney, 20; Johns Hopkins, 15; Bridgewater, 13½; Baltimore Loyola, 12; Lynchburg College, 11; American University, 10½; Gallaudet, 8; Washington College, 7½; Randolph-Macon, 7, and Western Maryland, 3.

Johnston's record clocking in the 220-yard low hurdles was 24.1 seconds, a tenth of a second faster than the old record of 24.2 established only last year by Roanoke's Dave Foltz. In the high hurdles, Johnston was timed in 15.1, same as the record held by Foltz.

Hampden-Sydney's Jim Frazer, who had set a new standard in the discus in yesterday's trials, set another in today's finals. Frazer tossed the plate 147 feet, 1½ inches to eclipse his throw in the preliminaries by nearly one foot.

Frazer, like Johnston, was a double winner, annexing the shot put with a heave of 48 feet, 1¾ inches, far off his record of 48 feet, 10½ inches set last year.

Today's other record-smasher was Taylor Goode, Lynchburg's fine pole vault specialist, who cleared the bar at 13 feet, 2½ inches, an inch higher than his own 1956 record.

The afternoon's easiest winner was Gallaudet's Steve Kugel in the two mile run. Kugel hit the tape more than 100 yards in front of his closest pursuer, Dick Nelson of Catholic University, who earlier had captured the mile run. The favorite in the two mile, Howard Meincke of Roanoke, dropped out early. Miencke finished second in the mile.

Johns Hopkins and Catholic University split up the dashes, Hopkins' John Heck annexing the 100-yard dash in 10 second flat and CU's defending champion John Libert winning the 220 in 22.0 seconds.
