

EMMITSBURG, Md. (AP)—Mt. St. Mary's won only one field event Saturday, but placed in enough other events to win its first Mason-Dixon Conference track championship.

The Mounts racked up 33½ points, including their lonely first in the mile relay. Old Dominion, champ of the Little Eight, was second with 33 points.

Roanoke, the defending champion who had the largest number of qualifiers with 10, placed third with 26. American University had 25 points.

Old Dominion's Ron Etheredge was the only double winner of the day, taking firsts in the 100- and the 220-yard dashes.

Three conference records were broken. Jim Hackett of American U. ran the 120-yard hurdles in 0:14.4, breaking the old 1960 record of 0:14.6. Dick Nicholas of Old Dominion added an inch to the 1959 record by an inch to the 1959 record by pole vaulting 13 feet 5 inches. George Gillock of Bridgewater ran the 440-yard dash in 0:49.3, shaving 2-10ths of a second off the 1960 record.

The Mt. St. Mary's track team has a 16-0 record for two seasons of undefeated running in dual meets.

The old conference champs, Roanoke, now has won six out of nine of the Mason-Dixon championship meets. Catholic U. defeated them in 1958, and American turned the trick in 1960.
