

MOUNTS WIN TRACK TITLE

American U. Is Runner-Up In Mason-Dixon Meet

Washington, May 16 (AP)—Mount St. Mary's College of Emmitsburg, Md., won its second straight Mason-Dixon Conference track championship today, edging American University 58* to 55*.

Old Dominion College of Norfolk, Va., was third with 31 points and Gallaudet College of Washington, fourth with 30 points.

The margin of victory resulted from a dropped baton by American University in the 440-yard relay, as the school failed to finish.

Three records were set, all by American University. Bob Campbell ran the 440-yard dash in 48.3 seconds, breaking his own mark of 49.3 seconds set yesterday.

Jim Hackett ran the 330-yard intermediate hurdles in 37.9 seconds and the A.U. relay team of Rick Boroto, Ed Ball, Hackett and Campbell, won the mile relay in 3.16.4.

Mount St. Mary's won five events, two of them by Bill Walsh, who jumped 43 feet, 8 inches in the mile run for Mount St. Mary's in 4.28.7 while teammate Ken Swomley won the 100-yard dash in 10.4 seconds. The Maryland School also won the 440-yard relay in 43.6 seconds.

The scores of other entries: Catholic University, 17; Lynchburg, 9; Washington College, 8; Randolph-Macon and Towson (Md.), 7 each; Roanoke and Bridgewater, 5 each; Loyola of Baltimore, 4, and Johns Hopkins, 3. Baltimore and Western Maryland failed to score.
