

Ennis Sets Pace As Catholic Takes Mason-Dixon Track

Emmitsburg, Md., May 11 [Special] — Catholic University scored in twelve of eighteen events this afternoon and easily captured the thirty-fourth annual team championship in the Mason-Dixon Conference outdoor track championships. The Cardinals finished with 68 points.

Junior Bill Ennis, who yesterday set a conference record in the 220, led coach Jerry McGee's team with three firsts and a leg on a second-place 440-yard relay team. Ennis won the long jump, 22-3, then was caught in 49.1 for the 440 and 22.0 for the 220. His 220 mark is 21.7.

Mounts Second

Defending champion Mount St. Mary's, team winner in four of the last five years, was second with 48 points, trailed by Bridgewater, 40, and Towson State, 34. Rain fell during most of the afternoon and Mount St. Mary's all-weather track provided an adequate surface.

Tom Woolfolk's discus trial mark of yesterday, 151-2³/₄, stood up, while three meet records were bettered today. Bridgewater lowered the 440-yard relay time to 42.5; Towson State's Steve Mahieu knocked his own mile standard down to 4:18.1 and Jim Clarke of Mount St. Mary's dropped the two mile mark to 9:35.5.

Aside from Ennis's twin wins, the only other individual champ for the Washington (D.C.) school was Steve Costion of Hagerstown, who took his second straight 880 title, 1:54.6. The successful defenders were Ennis in the 440; Costion in the 880; Mahieu in the mile and Old Dominion's Terry Wright in the high jump.
