

# Roanoke Victor In Track Easily

Lexington, Va., Feb. 21 (AP)—Roanoke's defending champions won seven first places and tied for three others on the 12-event program here tonight to capture their sixth consecutive Mason-Dixon Conference indoor track and field championship with a total of 70½ points.

Howard Meincke was the outstanding performer for the Maroons with a record-shattering clocking of 1.59.8 in the 880-yard run as they outscored their combined opposition for the second year in a row.

Bridgewater was a distant second with 20½ points, barely ahead of third-place Hampden-Sydney, which had 20. Trailing were Mount St. Mary's with 18 and Lynchburg with 3.
