

Mounties Win Mason-Dixon

LEXINGTON, Va. (AP)—Mt. Saint Mary's freshman Barry Stebbins won three events, placed second in two more and third in another Tuesday as the Mounties won the Mason-Dixon Conference indoor track championship.

Stebbins, 19, scored a total of 29½ points, winning the long jump, 60-yard dash and the 60-yard hurdles. He placed second in the pole vault and high jump and third in the triple jump.
