

# 10 Records Go by Boards as Huskies Romp

Ten new Metropolitan Conference meet records were established at Santa Monica last night as the East Los Angeles Jaycee Huskies dethroned Bakersfield's defending track and field champs.

The Huskies amassed 69 points as they annexed five events. Bakersfield placed second with 57 points, followed by Santa Monica, 43; San Diego, 22½; El Camino, 11½; Valley, 10, and Harbor, 5.
