

Anderson Runs

49.1 Quarter

Quarter-miler Clarence Anderson strode to a 49.1 440 triumph as he helped his Valley College team capture the All-Metropolitan Conference track championship last night at Corsair Field in Santa Monica.

Anderson's speedy clocking was the fastest of the season by a Southern California jay-see.

Coach Jim Slosson's Valley lads won the title by a margin of one point, totaling 56½ to East Los Angeles' 55½. Harbor, Santa Monica, Bakersfield, Long Beach and El Camino followed in that order. San Diego did not compete.

Four new meet records were established as Santa Monica's Mason Benner heaved the shot 53ft. 1in., East Los Angeles' Franklin Chong broad-jumped 22ft. 5in., East Los Angeles' Sherwin Sosnovsky twirled the discus 149ft. 1in., and Valley's Ralph Avalon, a surprise victor, vaulted 13ft. 1½in.
