With only four men entered at the Middle Atlantics held on Saturday at Swarthmore, Muhlenberg finished fourth, the team scoring ten points. Ruggers was first with a score of 48 points; Swarthmore second with 33 points and Lafayette third with 315-6 Stevens was fifth with 81-3; Delaware, 7½; New York U., J; Haverford, 4 \$3; Washington and Jefferson, 3; Lehigh, 1.

Erh won the half mile for Muhlenterg in the fast time of 2 minutes 23-5 seconds. Considering the condition of the track which resembled a canal the time is unusually fast and speak well for the local runr.er.
