The 1941 Championships were held at Muhlenberg College, Allentown, Pennsylvania on Friday, May 9 and Saturday, May 10, 1941.

The weather Friday afternoon was very cool and cloudy, ending in downpour of rain—but sixteen colleges entered in keen competition. On Saturday, the weather clouded and a very high wind was in evidence. The were also intermittent showers.
