M. A. S. C. A. A. 1941 TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Held at Muhlenberg College, Allentown, Pennsylvania, May 9 and 10, 1941

The 1941 Championships were held at Muhlenberg College, Allentown, Pennsylvania on Friday, May 9 and Saturday, May 10, 1941.

The weather Friday afternoon was very cool and cloudy, ending in downpour of rain—but sixteen colleges entered in keen competition. On Saturday, the weather clouded and a very high wind was in evidence. There were also intermittent showers.

Winning three First Places and placing men in all but three of the fourteen events, 1. Lafayette College won the Twenty-ninth National Middle Atlantic States Collegiate Athletic Association Track and Field Championship with 43½ points. 2. Alfred University of Alfred, New York, was second with 27½ points, and the other colleges placed as follows:
