

Rutgers Wins Track Crown

LANCASTER, Pa., May 11.—Despite an amazing series of performances by Jim Gillcrist, Swarthmore College was dethroned by Rutgers University in the 34th annual Middle Atlantic Collegiate Track and Field Championships today at Franklin and Marshall College.

Rutgers amassed 38 points, 11 more than Swarthmore. F. & M. placed third with 22, while Lafayette nipped St. Joseph's for fourth, getting 18½ to 18. Sixth went to Bucknell with 16, followed by Lehigh, 13½; Muhlenberg, 12 5-6; Haverford, 12; Juniata, 11; Ursinus, 7; Delaware and Drexel, 4; Alfred, 3½, and Gettysburg, 1.

SETS HIGH JUMP RECORD

Gillcrist, a Naval R.O.T.C. Swarthmore yearling, established the lone new championship record when he cleared the high jump at 6 feet, 2 inches to better by one-eighth inch the mark created by George Verrill, Rutgers, in 1938.

Swarthmore Loses Title In M. A. Track to Rutgers

Y. J. High School ace was individual high scorer, contributing 15 of Swarthmore's 27 points. He was the meet's lone double winner.

FIRST IN LOW HURDLES

Aside from the high jump, he finished first in the 220-yard low hurdles, placed third in the discus and fourth in the shot put.

Charles James was the next most prolific scorer, earning 13 for Rutgers by winning the discus and placing second in the shot and javelin. Hen Diller, F. & M. distance star, gave his team 12 with a thrilling mile victory over Haverford's Jim Grosholz and second in the two mile and third in the javelin.

A bad break in the 120-yard high hurdles deprived Swarthmore's broad jump winner, Bob Vernon, of two first places. Leading over the first seven hurdles, he tripped on the

next, wavered off the track and then toppled face first over the ninth hurdle.

Following his defeat in the mile, Grosholz staged a splendid comeback in the 880 when he dethroned Bill Wenner, Swarthmore's 1945 champion, in 2 minutes, 1.6 seconds. They staged a two-man race, leaving the rest of the field behind. Wenner made a game bid on the final turn, but Grosholz had a kick in reserve and won by five yards.

Charles Cramer won the 100, and Adrian Mancusi-Ungaro, in the 440, were Rutgers' other winners, aside from James.

Although it failed to take a first, St. Joseph's made a creditable showing. Bob Schuenerman placed third in high hurdles, fourth in low hurdles and fourth in the broad jump, while Bob Stratton was second in the 440 and Bob Maloney third in the 220-yard dash. Francis Gavin finished third in the two-mile.
