

LaSalle College of Philadelphia successfully defended its Middle Atlantic College Track and Field championship by amassing a total of $52\frac{3}{4}$ points in the 42nd annual meet on Williamson Field yesterday afternoon.

The Explorers topped a field of 17 schools. Lafayette, last year's runner-up, was again second with $37\frac{3}{4}$, St. Joseph's $29\frac{1}{4}$, Haverford $24\frac{1}{2}$.

Other schools finished in this order: Lehigh $16\frac{1}{2}$, Ursinus 10, Delaware $9\frac{1}{2}$, Albright 8, Swarthmore 5, Juniata 5, Gettysburg $4\frac{1}{2}$, Bucknell 4, PMC 3, and Scranton $\frac{1}{4}$. Franklin and Marshall, Muhlenberg and Dickinson failed to score.
