## Haverford wins MAC indoor title

CHESTER — Haverford College easily dethroned defending Middle Atlantic Conference champion Widener as the Fords romped in the MAC Indoor Track Championships Saturday.

Haveford (80 points) more than doubled the score of runnerup Moravian (38). Swarthmore finished third with 31 points, while host Widener was shut out.

Liam O'Neill was the big winner for Haverford as he swept to victory in the mile (4:24), took second in the 880 (1:59.9) and also anchored the Fords' triumphant mile relay team (3:31.8).

Henry Crawford took second in the two-mile with a time of 9:34.1, while Haverford teammate Ted Kuriger won the long jump (21-3), finished second in the triple jump and ran a leg on the Fords' winning sprint relay squad.

Jim Skeath and Jim Markham finished 1-2 in the 440 as Skeath came in with a clocking of 52.7, while Markham posted a 52.9.

## TRACK

In all, the Fords captured five individual events and all four relays to clinch their fourth title in seven years.

In the women's meet, Franklin & Marshall successfully defended its title by edging the combined team of Haverford-Bryn Mawr and Swarthmore by the slim margin of three points, 43-40.

The Carnet, however, took 1-2 in the high jump when Jen Sargent won the event with a leap of 5-2, with teammate Romano O'Halloran coming in second. O'Halloran also recorded third-place finishes in both the 60-yard dash and the shot put.

Haverford-Bryn Mawr's Mary Gilford won the 300 in 40.1 and took second in both the 60 and the long jump.
