RIPON, Wis. -- Seven of the ten Midwest Conference colleges today were feting individual track and field champions with Grinnell, copping its first track title since 1956, heading the list with three champs plus the first place relay team.

Grinnell had a double dinner with Fred Berg in the 100 and 220. Monmouth's Dave Campbell repeated as 880 king and also won the 440 while St. Olaf's Ken Hokeness took the shot and discus.

Hokeness also set the only meet record when he flipped the discus 150 feet, six and one-half inches to erase his own mark of 147 feet, 11 inches set a year ago.
