CHICAGO, ILL. — Chicago University withstood the challenges of Coe and Carleton this past weekend to win the Midwest Conference Indoor track meet held here.

Coe's Paul Wagner set a meet record in the pole vault with a jump of 13 feet 10 inches while Carleton's Todd Schaefer shattered the record in the two-mile run in 9 minutes 2 seconds.

James Francis of Coe tied the meet record in the 800 meters with a 1:56.5 clocking.
