

Coe has record day in track

CHICAGO, Ill. — Coe made a shambles of the Midwest Conference track record book Saturday, and former Cedar Rapids Kennedy standouts Greg Mick and Dan Vincent had a hand in an afternoon of outstanding performances.

The Kohawks established three conference marks in piling up 141 points — also a league mark — to easily outdistance the field in the annual Midwest Conference Indoor Track and Field Championships at the University of Chicago field house.

It was Coe's first indoor league championship since 1977.

Coe, second last year to Chicago, totaled nine points more than the previous conference mark of 132 points. The Kohawks easily breezed past runner-up Carleton (78 $\frac{1}{3}$) and defending champion Chicago (78).

Mick set a league and school record in the 400-meter run with a time of 49.9 seconds, while teammate Vincent was second in the 600-yard run in 1:13.8 to break another Coe mark. Mick also won the 60-yard dash.

The other Coe record-setters included high jumper Dan Meade of North Linn and pole vaulter Paul Wagner of Dubuque. Meade, fresh from leading Coe in scoring in basketball, leaped a conference record 6 foot, 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches. Wagner vaulted 14 feet to set a league mark.

Coe, which has won nine outdoor track titles, showed its versatility in winning six events. Another top area winner was West Union's Chuck Meyer, taking the triple jump with a leap of 44 feet, six inches.
