Baillie's Two Mile Run Is Tremendous

New Zealand's Bill Baillie, a tremendous fellow made a tremendous hit with the California Relays fans by setting a new meet record in the two mile run of 8:37.1 last night.

The 30 year old lumber salesman, who has taken a back seat to his fellow countrymen Peter Snell and Murray Halberg is finally getting a chance to prove himself after 10 years of running. He had a 56.8 second 440 kick.

He bested Bruce Kidd of Canada and American Jim Beatty in the tremendous race. Beatty, now a public relations man in North Caro-

lina, led for the first six laps when Kidd took the lead and Baillie moved up with him.

Baillie, the father of two, said he ran the race exactly as he had it planned. He said he knew he "had it won" at the gun lap.

"The wind bothered me some and I was glad I wasn't setting the pace. I felt sorry for poor Jimmie (Beatty) up there," he said.

This was the first time the New Zealander has run against Beatty, and it was only his third race in the United States. This was Beatty's first outdoor race of the year.

Edwin Roberts, the North

Carolina College sophomore, won the 100 yard dash in 9.4 seconds after winning his heat in the same time.

Roberts became the favorite in the race after the withdrawal of such headliners as Robert Hayes, Darel Newman and Harry Jerome.

It was the slowest Modesto winning time since 1960 when Grambling's Stone Johnson ran it at the same pace.

Utah's Blaine Lindgren duplicated Roberts' performance by winning his high hurdles heat and repeating in the finals at 13.8 seconds.

He ran a slow 14.2 in the trials. This again was the poorest Modesto time since 1960.

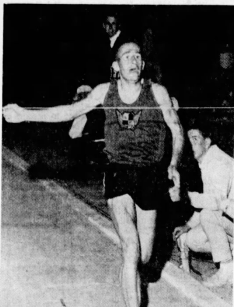
Toronto's Bill Crothers was beaten by Oregon Stater Jan Underwood in the invitational 880. Underwood, who also ran for the Beavers in the distance medley, was clocked in 1:48.7 seconds. Crothers' time was 1:49.1.

San Jose State freshman Tom Smith took the invitational 440 in 47.5 seconds beating former Texas prep standout Ted Nelson.

Rex Cawley, former Southern California Trojan, bested Ron Whitney, a one time Downey Knight in the 440 yard invitational hurdles. Cawley's time was 51.5 seconds with Whitney finishing three tenths of a second back.

In a special Olympic development race over the same distance, Roy Burluson of Pepperdine College won at 52.3 seconds.

Roberts became a double winner by taking the 220 in 20.8.
