

The Contests at Charter Oak Park Yesterday—One Record Broken.

The first annual field meeting of the New England Inter-Collegiate Athletic association was held at Charter Oak Park yesterday, the games beginning at 2:30 p. m. Notwithstanding the threatening aspect of the weather the night previous, the day was a beautiful one, with no wind to interfere with good records being made. The colleges which belong to the association and took part in the meeting were Dartmouth, Trinity, Brown, Amherst, Williams, Bowdoin and Wesleyan. In addition to the contestants from the different colleges, there was present a large number of students supporting their respective athletics. It had been expected that there would be a large attendance at these sports, but the number present was very small, not exceeding 400. When the nature of the games and the character of those participating in them are taken into consideration, it is a matter of surprise that the people of Hartford should not turn out in large force to view the contests. The number of spectators was scarcely one-third of those who almost daily witness a professional ball game on the Ward-street grounds. Charter Oak park is the most central and suitable place for these games, and upon the financial success of the meeting depends in a great measure the selection of the place for holding these yearly games. The track was somewhat heavy, thus preventing any exceptional records. This first meeting of the association was a great success, the New Haven record in the bar vault being broken by 1½ inches, and a record in the two-mile run being established.

Dartmouth and Amherst were tied for first place in the running high jump at 5 feet 6 inches.
