

# INTERCOLLEGIATE GAMES.

## Dartmouth Easily Won the Championship.

AMHERST SECOND, BROWN THIRD.

Carter of Trinity Won the Shot-Putting Hands Down—Second Also in Throwing the Hammer.

WORCESTER, Mass., May 24.—Dartmouth won the championship of the New England Intercollegiate Athletic Association at Worcester Oval this afternoon. The ground was in first-class condition and the grand stands were crowded with at least 3,000 spectators, many of them women. College colors were twined about the posts in the grand stands and college yells were continuous.

The sports were admirably managed by the Worcester Athletic Club. Six association records were broken as follows: 100-yard dash, H. S. Patterson, Williams, 10 $\frac{1}{4}$  seconds; mile run, J. O. Jarvis, Wesleyan, 4 minutes 32 1-5 seconds; 120 yards hurdle, S. Chase, Dartmouth, 163-5 seconds; two mile bike, E. M. Bliss, Amherst, 5 minutes 50 3-5 seconds; two mile run, J. O. Jarvis, Wesleyan, 10 minutes 8 2-5 seconds; throwing 16-pound hammer, George S. Ellis, Brown, 98 feet 3 $\frac{1}{4}$  inches. The following is the full summary:—

One-Mile Walk—H. F. Houghton, Amherst; L. P. Strong, Worcester; J. F. Chase, Wesleyan. Time, 7 minutes 19 4-5 seconds.

Two-Mile Run—J. O. Jarvis, Wesleyan; D. L. Sharpe, Brown; W. H. Parker, Worcester. Time, 10 minutes 8 3-5 seconds.

Pole Vault—H. L. Towne, Williams; second tie between J. A. Derby, Worcester; M. D. Dunning, Amherst; E. O. Smith, Wesleyan. Distance, 10 feet 6 inches. Tie at 10 feet 4 inches. In drawing for prizes Derby got second and Dunning third.
