

Dartmouth Wins at Worcester.

Dartmouth College carried off the honors in the New England Intercollegiate athletic games at Lake View Oval, Worcester, Saturday. The result by points was as follows: Dartmouth 33, Brown 22, Amherst 19½, Massachusetts Institute of Technology 17, Williams 16½, Bowdoin 10, Wesleyan 8, Worcester Techs 5, Trinity 4, Vermont University 0.

Stephen Chase of Dartmouth and the New York Athletic Club was easily the sensation of the day. He won the 220 hurdles, coming within a fifteenth of a second of the association's best mark. He took but one trial in the wide jump in which he won and created a new association record, and to cap the climax he touched the world record in the 120-yard hurdles held by himself, doing the distance in 15¾ seconds on a heavy track, which was offset by having a stiff breeze at his back. Smith of Brown also made a new record with the hammer. Four records were broken as follows:—

100 yards dash, 10¼s., held by H. S. Patterson of Williams, by H. S. Patterson in 10 1-5s.

120 yards hurdle, 16s., held by S. Chase of Dartmouth, by S. Chase, 15 3-5s.

Throwing 16-pound hammer, 109 feet 10 inches, held by F. E. Smith of Brown; by F. E. Smith, 113 feet ½ inch.

Running broad jump, 22 feet 2 3-5 inches, held by F. W. Marvel of Brown, by S. Chase, 22 feet 3 inches.

One Mile Walk—Won by Houghton, Amherst; Bliss, Williams, second; Tizzer, Brown, third. Time, 7 minutes 17 3-5 seconds.

Two-Mile Run—Won by Soule, Bowdoin; Sutton, Wesleyan, second; Pringle, Dartmouth, third. Time, 10 minutes 29 3-5 seconds.

Putting 16-Pound Shot—Won by Smith, Brown, 38 feet 2½ inches; Mason, Dartmouth, second, 36 feet 6 inches; Tyler, Amherst, third, 36 feet 5 inches.

Throwing 16-Pound Hammer—Won by Smith, Brown, 113 feet ½ inch (record); Coombs, Brown, second; Kimball, Bowdoin, third.

Pole Vault—Won by Morgan, Amherst, 10 feet; Wyatt, Wesleyan, second, 10 feet; Dunning, Amherst, third, 9 feet 6 inches. First and second man tied, Wyatt winning the toss. Dunning also tied Fifer of Williams for third and won the toss. The points for first and second were equally divided between Morgan and Wyatt, and Dunning and Fifer also divided the point for third.
