Williams Wins, with Amherst a Close Second.

Worcester, Mass., May 19 .- The annual meeting of the New England Intercollegiate Athletic Association was held here yesterday in the rain. Williams won with a total of 32 1-6 points. while Amherst was second with 32 points. The other colleges that scored were Dartmouth, 19 1-6; Bowdoin, 18 1-6; Brown, 16 1-6, and Boston Technology, 8 1-3. Other colleges represented were Wesleyan, Trinity, Tufts, Worcester Polytechnic Institute and

Maine University.

In spite of the bad weather two records were broken and two equaled. Cloudman of Bowdoin beat the record of Chase of Dartmouth in the broad jump by an inch, and equaled the record of Curtenius of Amherst, of 10 seconds, in the 100-yards dash. McDonald of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology put the shot 39 feet 11 inches, as against 38 feet 101/2 inches, the former record, held by Melendy of Brown. Edson of Dartmouth equaled the record of Burch of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in the low hurdles in the fast time of 25 4-5 seconds. As last year Cloudman of Bowdoin was the star point winner of the meet, with
