

AMHERST ATHLETES WIN.

Five New Records in New England College Games.

Worcester, Mass., May 25.—Amherst won the honors in the New England intercollegiate games here yesterday. Dartmouth was second and Brown third. Five new records were made, including the broad jump by Van Weelden of Trinity. Besides capturing this event in the finals Van Weelden won third in the high jump, giving Trinity a total of 5½ points. The new records are indicated in the summary. The results by points:—
