AMHERST WINS THE MEET AT WORCESTER.

Williams Second and Technology Third—Trinity Scores Three Points.

The meeting of the New England Intercollegiate Athletic Association at Worcester Saturday was won by Amherst with a total of fifty-one points; Williams, second, thirty-two points; Technology, third, thirty points; Dartmouth, fourth, fifteen points; Bowdoin and Wesleyan tied for fifth, thirteen points; Brown, sixth, seven points; Trinity, seventh, three points; Maine University, eighth, one point. Only one record was broken—the broad jump. H. C. Van Weelden of Trinity made a new record last year, going 22 feet $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches, but W. P. Hubbard of Amherst smashed it Saturday, when he covered 22 feet 7 inches.

The 880-yard run was one of the best events. Taylor of Amherst won out with hands down; Newell of Williams finished second and R. F. Patterson of Trinity third. The other point scored by Trinity was made by Lycett in the two-mile bicycle race Friday. The summary:—
