

Cambridge, Mass., May 24.—(AP.)—A hard running and far jumping group of state of Mainers gave their university its fourth straight victory in the New England intercollegiate here today. First places in the two mile, broad jump and discus and lesser scoring places in other events entitled the boys from the home of the Acad song to a close win over 16 other colleges.

Two new records were set by Forsberg's heave of 188 feet, 2 3/4 inches in the javelin and Chapman's time of 1 minute and 54 3-5 seconds in the half. Chapman, running for Bates, broke the old record of 1:55 and Forsberg of Northeastern, cracked the old mark of 184 feet, 11 inches.

Maine scored 26 1/2 points, Northeastern 24, Holy Cross 22, Bates 20, Bowdoin 12, New Hampshire and Worcester Tech 10 each, Brown 9 1/2, Massachusetts Tech, hosts at the meet, 9, Boston College 8, Connecticut Aggies and Wesleyan 5 each, Boston University 3 and Colby 2.
