

MAINE PUTS 13 MEN IN PORTLAND FINALS

Kishon Sets New Discus Record in Qualifying Tests of New England College Meet

PORTLAND, Me., May 24—The men coming from the University of Maine this afternoon showed enough power, balance and technical standards to lead a field of 21 colleges over the qualifying tests of 18 events at the New England intercollegiate track and field championships swept away from the post for the 20th time.

Maine, undefeated in its dual meet season, cast its challenge to the field by placing men in the finals of eight of the 11 events contested on the Municipal Stadium grounds. The blue-shirted boys from Orono sent 13 men along to spectators' entertainment for the real struggle for the all-important post.

Track Shows Up Well

Over 1000 men from 20 colleges, despite the pressure of examinations this week, were very much on deck and full of power, qualifying 18 men.

Maine, entering itself in the hammer throw and discus, will send eight men into Saturday's competitions, as will Bowdoin, the defending champion which will be hard pressed to meet.

Twelve will not, this Holy Cross getting in last, though, and while Ben Sullivan's boys can show only six qualifiers as a result of today's proving, they were the only ones to finish the first half of the track.

Northeastern, suffering a let-down in the high hurdles; Boston College and Rhode Island State each qualified two men. New Hampshire four, Springfield State and Massachusetts State and Brown two apiece, Williams, Colgate, Worcester P. I. City, Boston University and Tufts got one man over the treacherous gate to the finals.

Maine is definitely the team to beat among the Northeastern and Holy Cross with the possible exception of Tufts, despite the failure of the former's Al Hakkanen to come up to expectations.

The Holy Cross, State champions, have distinguished their qualifiers and at the same time have concentrated strength with which to attack in the half-mile, three quarters and the three miles.

Holy Cross' Tommy Gilligan won his trials in both dashes with ease and Carl Timony King is by all accounts the class of the quarter-mile field.

King galloped away from Tom Kline, his junior in the final at Springfield last year, to win the final qualifying heat by eight yards in 38.46. Just Bert Graham, power ridden Falmouth sophomore, rushed down the stretch with a nice kick to head out first place in the second heat in 38.12. It is his record to his captain in the final as he might, the Purple will give Maine a total time of 2 for 24.74.

A brace of athletes provided the trouble touch in one lone record was produced in the event, upper State sophomore, Stuart Parks of Springfield was in the final of the event, the result of the faring and the final of the broad jump.

Shows Mark for Kishon

Boston College's leading muscle man, John Kishon of Worcester Worcester Anthony Lane, shot one most record 211 of holes while on his way to qualifying for these finals. His record production came in the discus, 210.40 his disc of 130 feet two inches placed the 14.11. Bill Charles set up a 202 for Bowdoin.

Dr. Kishon's specialty is the hammer and he is running third behind Larry Johnson of Tufts and George Frazer of Maine, with a very unorthodox throw of 132 feet 8 inches. The big boy also went into the final of the weight, which field is headed by Harvey Bate of Boston College with 474.5.

All events but the hammer and 400 were brought down to the final this afternoon the semifinals of the long jump came at 3:30 p. m. This is an 50 feeters King of Holy Cross, who he qualified there, as well as in the quarter.

No competitions were conducted in the high jump, vault, pole or two-mile relay, which events are all still tomorrow. Maine expects to hit

and hit hard in the mile with Ernie Black and Harry Saunders.

Northeastern hopes for many points from Jim Sandler and Ivo Kainian in the high jump, while Holy Cross looks to see its Ed Kenney chase Vesper of Colby home at two miles and thereby sew up the meet for Worcester.

Nothing bordering on ignominy occurred this afternoon. Phil Good, Bowdoin's J. C. 4-A. high and national A. A. U. low-hurdle champ, won his trial starts in dashes of his two New England titles. The lack of North Portland, as well as all of the nine other defending champions, qualified.

'Til the Rufflers Ring

Johnny Joyce of Boston College stood up well despite the pulled muscle which has held him back for months, and will be a finalist in the 100-yard dash. "Jigger" looked good in winning his heat and eased off to take second in his semifinal.

Several pulled muscles featured the trials of the century, with Bert Hicks of Middlebury and Mulloney of Maine suffering severe injuries, both while leading, near the worst.

What with Stroud of Amherst, runner-up in 1934, not competing or even being in town, the high hurdles may offer Northeastern something substantial in the way of points, even if only Ray Houghton went to the final. The champion's heavy sophomore looked impressive in both hurdles heats.

The prearranged meet put all the field events men under firm so that, aside from Kishon's cast of the discus, nothing startling was accomplished ahead.

Eddie Hatch, Worcester P. I.'s undefeated sprinter, did not compete in the century because of a bad leg. He ran, however, in the furlong, where he chased Gilligan home in his heat.

With Bill Brews of Rhode Island State out of the meet, Maine may pick up some unanticipated, juicy points in the hammer with Francis Brews, who is consistent at 160 feet. Was struck by a flying discus in Kingston two days ago and badly cut and bruised.

A blanket finish of the most unusual order came in the third trial of the half-mile, wherein Francis of Brown, Minnick of Amherst, Cooper of Tufts and Cowan of Bowdoin swept into the post in a wild, disorderly windup. Cowan was sipped out of a qualifying position.

The attendance, about 1200, was a good showing. By the way, as we write this and dusk is setting over the field, workers are filling in large holes in the track with earth. The track is very slow and no record performances are likely to be fashioned upon it tomorrow.

That's how close it was and the biggest crowd to attend one of these shindigs in years, 5,000 people, waited to the very last vault.

Two new records were broken, Bates brilliant star, Aileen "Tony" Kishon bettering his discus record of the trials by more than four feet heaving the platter 154 feet, one inch while Tim Salts of Boston College bettered the shot put mark with a toss of 50 feet, 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches.

Maine lost the chance to keep the title when Eddie Mack was shot out of the mile and neither Murray nor Hall were able to grab a place in a thrilling 100 yard dash.

As the earlier and shorter running events were run off, Holy Cross took a commanding lead and some of the track experts in the press box were giving the most to the purple Crossmen. Others had a leaning towards Maine but none of them seemed to be considering Maine or Northeastern and as matters turned out, either one could have topped the title had the pole vault not ended in a three way tie.

Maigher Did Best

Maine folks have nothing to feel bad about because their ace jumper, Maigher didn't cop. Louis was vaulting better than ever and he did well to stay in there with Fairman of Northeastern and Holleran of Maine as long as he did. They went 11 feet, three-quarters of an inch.

Then in the hammer, the Bobcats grabbed nice points with Larry Johnson winning. Gibson taking second and Bob Anselmi coming through again in fine style to take that valuable fourth place point. That was the best sprang any college did in a single event, the nearest anybody else came to approaching it was when Ed Black took the half mile closely followed by Fred March for eight points.

Good Gate Award

Fred Good of Bowdoin was the only dual winner and, incidentally, the high point man of the meet with 18 points. He took his two specialties, the hurdles, and in such a convincing manner as to be sure him the award as the meet's most outstanding athlete.

Gibson was a close second with his first and record breaking throw in the discus, second in the hammer and fourth in the shot for nine points.

Race Competition

Competition was keen all the way and sportsmanship was a predominating feature of the day. It was a perfect day for the meet but a slow track prevented any efforts at records in the running events. The broad jump was probably one of the most closely contested events, the athletes after another having the measure by nine feet. Louis of an inch and finally it was won by Parks of Springfield with a jump of 23 feet, 1 1/2 inches which was 1/2 of an inch better than Johnson of M. I. T.

There was something of a surprise in the 100 yard dash when Hatch of Worcester Polytech came through to pass out Chicago of Holy Cross and preventing him from being a double winner. King of the Cross, who won the 440 as generally expected, was tied and Phillips of E. T. who beat Gilligan in the semi-finals, was fourth.
