

Willoughby Wins Broad Jump Crown

Fehr, Auten And Kelley Also Score

Cambridge, Mass., May 13 —(AP)—The track team of Massachusetts Institute of Technology, competing against nine rival outfits on MIT's home field, today won the New England Intercollegiate Track Championship with a team total of 32½ points, only a half-point in front of Tufts College of Medford with 32.

Other teams and their scores: Brown 23; Boston College 18; Bowdoin 16; Worcester Polytechnic Institute 14; Rhode Island State 12; Holy Cross 6½; Northeastern 5; Bates 2.

The Rhode Island State team entered the meet as defending champion but was out-manned in entries.

The small but potent Bowdoin squad gave a good account of itself in finishing fifth. Ralph Willoughby of the Polar Bears captured the broad jump with a leap of 21 feet 9 inches and was runner-up in the 100 yard dash to score half of his team's points. Roy Fehr's second in the mile, Fred Auten's third in the two mile and Don Kelley's second in the discus throw completed the Bowdoin scoring.

High scoring individual of the meet was Hugo Norrige of Worcester Tech and East Hartford, Conn., with 12 points gained by victories in the discus throw and shot put and third in the javelin throw.

Herb McKenley of Boston College, National junior champion, successfully defended his New England titles in the 440-yard run and the 220-yard dash and established a new Briggs Field record in the quarter-mile in 48.3 seconds, the only record of the meet.

Nineteen-year-old Duncan Blanchard of Tufts and Pittsfield won the mile in four minutes, 31 seconds and the two-mile in nine minutes, 55.8 seconds with only a 15-minute rest between events.
