

Crusaders Capture Crown In New England Track

PROVIDENCE, R.I., (AP) — Three meet records were broken Saturday as Holy Cross won the 78th New England intercollegiate AAA track meet with a total of 33 points at Brown Stadium.

Brown was second with 29 points, followed by Northeastern 27, Central Connecticut 18, Boston College 17 and Rhode Island 14.

Meet records were broken by Dan Banks of Central Connecticut, discus, Clayton Clature of Rhode Island, pole vault, and Carl Wallin of Northeastern, shot put.
