

# Boston College Takes Title In N. E. Track Meet

NEWTON, Mass. — (AP) Host Boston College captured only one event but piled up points with over-all balance Saturday in winning the 69th New England Intercollegiate Track championships.

The Eagles earned 33 points, including 7 in the discus, 6 in the shot put, 6 in the mile and 5 in the hammer throw, in winning the title outright for the first time since 1933. They shared the crown with Boston University in 1962.

The lone BC winner was Jim Kavanagh, a sophomore from Providence, R.I., who took the discus with a heave of 162 feet, 11 inches.

Central Connecticut picked up three firsts and was second with 26 points, despite the absence of sprint star Walt Fitzpatrick, who broke an ankle recently.

Defending champion Holy Cross was third with 25 points and Boston University fourth with 20. Providence was fifth with 17 points, all scored by distance aces Barry Brown and Jerry Riordan.

Trailing in order were Brown 16, Northeastern 15, Rhode Island 14, Bowdoin 11, Bates 10½, Worcester Tech 10, Maine 9, Connecticut and Trinity 8 each, Springfield 5, New Hampshire 4½, Massachusetts, Vermont, Wesleyan and Williams 4 each, Southern Connecticut and Tufts 3 each, and MIT 1.
