

Glassboro State won 12 of 18 events and rolled up a record 146 points yesterday in winning the New Jersey State College Athletic Conference outdoor track and field championship yesterday in Pomona.

Meanwhile, Jersey City State's Khaliem Jamar Morgan won the 100 meter dash in a meet record :10.5 and finished second in the 200 dash, accounting for 10 of the Gothics' 12 points.

Former Snyder High stars Alvin Robinson and Bob Lee played key roles for the Profs. Both ran on the winning 1,600 meter relay team while Robinson was second in the 800 meters and Lee ran on the winning 400 meter relay.
