

Bemidji, Minn.—(Special)—Placing in every event on the program, Winona Teachers finished second behind Mankato here Saturday in the annual funning of the Minnesota State College conference track and field meet.

Mankato walked off with 94 points to Winona's 48 with St. Cloud third. The three schools finished in identical order in the Minnesota-Wisconsin conference meet last week in Winona.

Three new records were established and all were by Mankato, powerhouse of the league.

Wagner of Mankato threw the shot 44 feet, two inches to better the 1941 record of 42-11 held by Wall of the same school.

In the 220-yard low hurdles, Al Reader skipped the distance in :24.5 breaking the 15-year-old record of Hoerr of Mankato who did :25.2.

was clocked in 1:32.6 Saturday. That performance eclipsed Winona's 1:33 set in 1936 and equaled by Mankato last spring.

Only first place for the Warriors was chalked by Joe Lynch who won the 440-yard dash in :52.7. He also is the M-W champion in that event. Lynch took second in the 220-yard dash and ran on the second-place 880-yard relay quartet.

John Anderson, freshman, was second in the high jump and the promising John Duls took a No. 2 post in the gruelling two-mile run. Andy Swota tied for third in the pole vault and Bob Clausen and Dave Todd were 3-4 in the century won by Jerry Springer of Mankato.

Mankato won eight first places in 14 events, St. Cloud three, Bemidji one and Winona one.
