

ABERDEEN — Moorhead State won the Northern Intercollegiate Conference men's track title Saturday.

Moorhead finished the two-day meet with 280 points. Northern State was a distant second with 96 points.

John Alin of Moorhead set a record of 3:55.11 in winning the 1500 meter run, and teammate Keith McCarty won the 400 meters in a record :48.3. McCarty also won the 200 meters in :21.39.

Other double-event winners were: Pat Billig of Moorhead in the 10,000 meters, 31:43.56, and 5,000 meters, 14:45.19; Kevin Johnson of Northern in the long jump, 21-11½, and triple jump, 45-10¾; and Todd Renner of Moorhead in the shot put, 54-3½, and discus, 154-10.

Other team points were Minnesota-Duluth 75, Winona State 72, Minnesota-Morris 27, Bemidji State 23, and Southwest State 16.
