The Marauders rewrote a few of the NSIC records. Blazer won the 400-meter hurdles in a record time of 1:01.96. She also anchored the record-setting 1,600 relay (3:50.18). Hannah Moen, Michelle Huxtable and Betsy Bischoff also ran on the relay.

The 400 relay team of Bischoff, Marsha-Gaye Knight, Kacie Sweep and Mishay Weber set a meet record in a time of 47.48.

Blazer picked up her third first when she won the 400 (56.33). Moen won two individual events — 800 (2:12.90) and 1,500 (2:12.90).

Sweep won the 100 (12.21). Weber won the 200 (25.68) and Ashley Gram-

mens won the triple jump 38-0¼.

The Marauders competed on Saturday without their top triple jumper Destinee Keller, who was traveling to Korea. They also competed without Sweep in the 200 because of a hamstring injury.

Wayne State won the men's division with 166 points. U-Mary was sixth with 76.
