

ESSEX COUNTY COLLEGE WINS NJCAA TRACK AND FIELD CROWN

Essex County College of Newark, New Jersey won the 32nd Annual NJCAA Track and Field Championship at Mesa, Arizona. Essex County College became the first eastern college in the history of the event to win the championship.

Terry Porter of Ranger J.C. (Texas) set a new pole vault mark, while Marvin Jones of John C. Calhoun C.C. (Georgia) set a new triple jump mark. Ralph Fisher of North Platte J.C. (Nebraska) equaled the 120 HH mark, as did Ainsley Armstrong of Essex County College in the 100 yard dash.

The high point award for the meet went to Vesco Bradley of Seminole (Oklahoma) Junior College. Jerry Isom of Miami-Dade JC South was named "Coach of the Year" by the NJCAA Track Coaches Association.

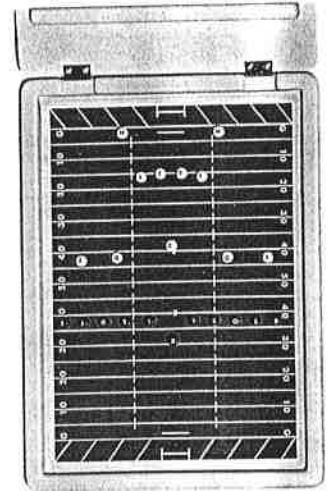
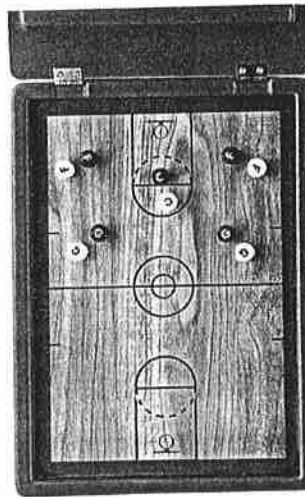
